



HIRED. Private Bank of Buckhead has hired a new executive to oversee lending and credit evaluation, and added a new role for another senior manager.

The bank added Tony Webb to serve as chief lending officer.

Webb will oversee both lending and credit underwriting for the Buckhead-based community bank, which has \$55 million in total assets. He replaces Chris Douglas, who joined the bank's founding executive team from **BB&T Corp.**

Douglas left last fall to rejoin BB&T, and Private Bank of Buckhead had been filling his role on an ad hoc basis with

other employees and outside contractors.

Webb joins the bank from **North Atlanta National Bank**. The Alpharetta-based bank sold last year to New York-based **Shinhan Bank America**.

Private Bank of Buckhead also added the title chief operating officer for chief financial officer Terry Freeman.

Freeman will now formally oversee the bank's human resources, operations and technology.

Bank CEO Charlie Crawford said Freeman previously did those duties informally as part of the bank's senior management team.
